Each year the Office of Marine Programs recruits graduate students, staff and faculty as Outreach Scientists to present Interpretative Programs and lead Field Trips for K-12 students, teachers, and public groups through URI's Narragansett Bay Classroom.

Outreach Scientists are paid between \$60 and \$75 for each activity-oriented 45-minute interpretative program (sometimes at the Bay Campus and sometimes at various school locations throughout the state). Auditorium presentations for larger groups pay between \$80 and \$120. The pay for 2-hour field trips to Fort Getty, Beavertail, East Beach/Ninigret Pond, or Galilee Marsh, or aboard the Cap'n Bert, is \$120-\$150 per trip depending on the number of people in the group.

Field trip locations are already established, although we are always open to new suggestions. All programs will be scheduled at your convenience.

If you are interested in serving as an Outreach Scientist for the Fall 2008 and/or Spring 2009 semesters, please send me an email. An informational meeting is set for Thursday, October 2, at 4:00 pm in the Hazard room A at the Coastal Institute (Narragansett Bay Campus).
